



Advert for SEMH Teaching Partner / Midday Supervisor

The Head Teacher and Governors of The John Moore Primary School are looking to appoint an outstanding, enthusiastic and motivated Teaching Partner to join our sparkling team, to provide SEMH support for a child in our KS2 phase. This post will be for 17.5 per hours a week as a Teaching Partner (Grade 3 – 5 depending on qualifications & experience) and 5.0 hours a week as a Midday Supervisor (Grade 2) term time only. This is a fixed term contract linked to the child's pastoral plan and will be reviewed annually.

Teaching Partner hours will be 17.5 hours per week (mornings only) – 8:30 – 12:00 am

Midday Supervisor working hours will be 5.0 hours per week (spread over 5 x 1.0 hour sessions) – 12:00 – 1:00 pm

The successful candidate should ideally:

- Be a successfully qualified and experienced Teaching Assistant
- Have experience and expertise of supporting children with SEMH needs.
- Be willing to work in any class within the school in the future.
- Be able to demonstrate a high level of commitment and initiative
- Be able to work with small groups of SEN pupils / intervention groups as required.
- Act as a general teaching assistant for in-class support if required.
